First steps ...

How to install locr the GPS Photo for Symbian

If you want to download, install and use the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software for geotagging, just do so. If you also want to upload photos to the locr web site you need an account and a password. For information on how to sign up at locr, please see the “How to sign up at locr” section on page 6.

To install the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software, you can download the installation program from the locr web site.



Please note: If there is a former version of locr GPS Photo for Symbian installed, you may have to delete it **before** installing the current version. For how to remove applications, please refer to your cell phone’s manual, if necessary.

Download and install the locr GPS Photo for Symbian

- On the locr web site (<http://www.locr.com>) click on “Downloads”, select “locr GPS Photo for Symbian”, and follow the instructions on the screen.



The locr GPS Photo for Symbian software will be downloaded to your PC. Please copy the “locr_xxx.sis” file to your cell phone after the download.

- Now, you can install the locr GPS Photo for Symbian on you cell phone. For how to install the locr application, please refer to your cell phone’s manual.

After the installation the locr GPS Photo for Symbian icon appears on the desktop.



How to use locr GPS Photo for Symbian

Starting locr GPS Photo for Symbian for the first time

If you start the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software for the first time you will be asked to define some general settings.

The “Start locr automatically when the device is rebooted?” option

If you want the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software to be started automatically whenever you switch on your cell phone, please select “Yes”. The locr GPS Photo for Symbian software will then run as a background application every time your cell phone will be restarted..

Selecting “No” means that you will have to start the application manually to use its functionality.

The “Settings” dialog

Next the “Settings” dialog will appear.

- **User name and Password**

You will be asked to enter your locr “User name” and your “Password”.

Please enter your name and password if you already have a locr account.

If you do not have an account yet, select “Yes” to create an account (also see the “How to sign up at locr” section on page 6), or “No” to skip this step.



Important: To upload your photos to the locr web site you need an account!

- **Access point**

Select the “Always ask” option if you want to select the desired connection whenever needed. If you activate “User defined”, please select the respective connection from the displayed list.

- **Photo privacy**

The default setting is “Public” which means that any photo you upload to the locr web site will be visible for everyone. If necessary, please change this setting.

- **GPS idle time**

This option allows you to set the time after which the GPS function will be disabled automatically. This feature helps to save your cell phone's battery power.

As the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software runs as a background application (after being started) the GPS function will automatically be activated whenever you take a photo!

- **Billable events**

You may be charged for any connection to the internet. If you select "Prompt" a warning will appear, whenever any billable event occurs. Changing the setting to "Accept" deactivates this message.

For more information on which connections may be charged, please refer to your contract.

- **Automatic start up**

Here again you can select whether the locr GPS Photo software should be started automatically whenever you switch on your cell phone.



Important: The "Settings" dialog will only appear when you start the locr GPS Photo for Symbian application for the first time. All settings will be saved. Whenever you want to change any setting, please select "Options" and "Settings"!

Using locr GPS Photo for Symbian

The locr GPS Photo for Symbian main menu offers five options:

- Take new photo
- Select photo
- Visit locr Website
- Show photos nearby
- Visit my locr gallery



Take new photo

Depending on your cell phone, you can either use the integrated GPS receiver, or use an external GPS Bluetooth receiver in addition.

If you select the “Take new photo” option, the GPS function will automatically be activated.

Having taken the photo the current GPS coordinate will be stored as a part of the photo. If no current but some already existing GPS position can be found, you will be asked whether the last known GPS position should be used. Select “Yes” if you want to save the photo with the GPS coordinates, or select “Cancel” if you want to save photo without GPS information.

If there is neither a current nor an already known GPS position, you will be informed that the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software will try to receive a current GPS position within the time interval you specified via the “Settings” dialog (default: 5 minutes).

Next you will be asked to edit the photo in locr. Here you can enter a comment, if you like.

Now, you can upload the taken photo to the locr web site. Therefore select “Options” and “Upload to locr”. Photos with GPS information will be uploaded **with the coordinates**, and can then be viewed on the locr web site with their position on the map and its appropriate address.



Please note! All your photos you upload to the locr web site will be uploaded with the privacy status defined in the “Settings” dialog (default: Public). That means they will be visible for everyone. If, necessary, change the settings before you upload the photos to the locr web site!

For how to change that status after uploading photos to locr, please refer to the “All around photos ...” section in the FAQs.

Select photo

“Select photo” lets you open your photos and edit the photo information.

You can

- Upload the respective photo to locr.
- Geotag
If any GPS information already exists, you will be asked whether the last know GPS position should be used for photos without GPS information. Or you can change the current GPS information for the respective photo.
- Enter text comment
Here you can enter a comment for your photo. This comment will then be uploaded, too. If you do not enter a comment, the file name will be used as a comment instead.
- Settings
Allows you to change the current settings.

Visit locr Website

You can visit the locr website at any time, regardless whether you’ve already uploaded photos or not.

In case you need some help or find some answers, simply click the “Help” tab. The browser will open, and you will find a comprehensive list of FAQs (**F**requently **A**sksed **Q**uestions).

Show photos nearby

The “Show photos nearby” option displays the public photos taken nearby of all locr members in the web browser.

Visit my locr gallery

Your click on “Visit my locr gallery” opens the locr web site in your web browser and lets you view your own photos uploaded to locr. In addition, you can you're your photos (rotate, change status, ...) on the locr web site.



Please do not forget: You may be charged for any connection to the internet. You may also be charged for uploading photos from your cell phone to the locr web site!

How to sign up at locr

Signing up at locr is blindingly easy.

- To sign up for the **first time** open the locr web site: <http://www.locr.com>,
or
use the “Sign up” option of the locr GPS Photo for Symbian software on your cell phone to open the web site.
- Click on “Sign up”.
(If you use your cell phone to sign up, this step does not exist.)

- In the next step, please fill the compulsory fields (with *).
- The Anti spam verification is obligatory (only if you sign up via the locr web site, not via your cell phone).
Therefore, in the list box please select the place name in the middle of the map.
- Click on “Create” to complete the registration.

You can change the password at any time.
